Petit - Small Grand - Big/Tall Jeune - Young Vieux - Old Gentil - Nice Bon - Good Facile - Easy Intelligent - Intelligent Beau - Handsome Fort - Strong	Petite - Small Grande - Big/Tall Jeune - Young Vielle - Old Gentille - Nice Bonne - Good Facile - Easy Intelligente - Intelligent Belle - Beautiful Forte - Strong	- Most French adjectives are placed after the noun (the word that they describe).  - The only adjectives that do not do this are the BANGS adjectives (adjectives about beauty, age, number, goodness, or size).  - Spelling of French adjectives can change depending on the number and gender of the noun that they describe.
