A number of topics were discussed including recent Ofsted inspections, SIAMS (church school inspection), and the Diocese

Janet talked about preparing for Ofsted. The second speaker was Afrasiab Anwar LCC Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Lead and the final speaker was Andrew Cook, head of OFSTED, he spoke about some of the challenges facing schools since the Covid pandemic and the importance of looking at school data. One aspect of national concern since the pandemic has been attendance at school. We reviewed our school attendance policy in the curriculum meeting and will be focusing on this as part of the school improvement plan. At our Full Governing Body meeting we receive a termly report from Mrs. Ip. This is will include attendance data which is also being shared in the school newsletters. This term we have been reviewing our governor visits to school. We will have a meeting with the subject leads and learn about the new developments in the curriculum.
